



How do I grow Paperwhites?




Paperwhites are a fragrant and welcome sight in the winter. They usually bloom 5 to 6 weeks after planting.



WATER METHOD

- In a watertight container, place stones, gravel, or marbles to desired depth. Place the bulbs on top, securing them with additional stones, gravel, or marbles.
- Add water to just below (but not touching) the bottoms of the bulbs.
- Place in a bright location and add water when necessary.



POT METHOD

- In a container with a drainage hole, fill part-way with soil. Place bulbs on soil, and fill so 2/3 of the bulbs are covered with the soil.
- Water thoroughly to settle soil, and add additional soil if necessary.
- Place in a bright location.
- Water sparingly at first, increasing frequency as the leaves grow.
