

# When do I plant fall bulbs?

The IDEAL time to plant most fall bulbs is in October after a hard (killing) frost. However, you can plant anytime from September through the ground freezing in early December.

Certain bulbs are exceptions because they dry out faster or have a different rooting habit. Anemone and Eranthis should be soaked in room-temperature water for a few hours prior to planting.

The following should be planted as soon as possible:



**Eranthis**
